Conference 1A-4A Schools

Meets / tournaments may begin after August 17, 2020.

Conference 5A/6A Schools

Meets / tournaments may begin after September 7, 2020.

Tournament Policies and Procedures Summary

Field Size

- Tournament hosts are encouraged to limit the field size to reduce large gatherings at the beginning and end of each round. It will be imperative that host schools follow state, county, and district guidelines to ensure a successful start to the 2020-2021 UIL calendar year. UIL has limited the field size to 18 teams and or 90 players.

Arrival Time

- It is recommended that players and spectators arrive at the golf course no earlier than forty-five (45) minutes prior to their starting time.

Flagsticks

- Players must not touch or remove the flagstick under any circumstances. Exception: A player may touch the flagstick with his/her putter in determining whether or not the ball has been holed.

Bunkers and Rakes

- Players will not be permitted to use bunker rakes regardless of whether rakes are provided by the golf course or not. Players are encouraged to smooth out their disturbances in the sand with their foot or club when leaving the bunker.
- Modified Model Local Rule E-3: Preferred lies will be in effect in all bunkers to prevent players from playing out of disturbed areas. If a player's ball is in a bunker they will be allowed to lift, clean, and place the ball within one club-length of where the ball came to rest. The new spot of the ball must be no closer to the hole and must remain in the bunker. A player may still elect to use relief options described under 16.1c (Abnormal Course Condition in Bunker), 16.2 (Dangerous Animal), and 19.3 (Unplayable Ball). The player must choose a spot to place the ball and use procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

Scorecards

- Scorecards will not be exchanged between players.
- At the conclusion of each hole, each player in the group will announce their score and it will be recorded by each player.
- Players must bring their own writing utensils for recording scores, as none will be provided on the starting tee, and players are not permitted to share.

Scoring Area

- Once the round is completed, players must walk straight from the final green to the scoring area with all of their equipment.
- Tables and chairs will not be available in the scoring area.
- Only one (1) group will be allowed into the scoring area at a time and all players will maintain 6 feet of distance between them.
- Players will confirm their scores verbally with the group and Head Coach. Two signatures will not be required to make the scorecard official.
- A scorecard will be considered “returned” once the player has verbally confirmed their scores with their group and their Head Coach, placed their scorecard in a designated dropbox, and leaves the scoring area.
- Traditional scoreboards and/or digital scoreboards will be removed from the scoring area.

Award Ceremonies

- NTHSGCA encourage our host schools to not conduct an in-person awards ceremony onsite following the tournament

Modified Maxwell Format

- Modified Maxwell Format allows tournament host schools to group players by schools (5 teammates playing together) rather than grouping schools together. Team scores will be the best 4 total scores for each round.
