Welcome

This years' nominated board members were introduced. Paula Adkison motioned for approval of the Board and the Booster seconded. The Board was voted in unanimously. Each board member described their role and duties on the board. Each parent introduced themselves and told who their golfer is.

PRESIDENT AND TREASURER REPORT

Lauraliisa explained the purpose of the golf Booster and the financial purpose of the Booster. Keith showed a breakdown of the budget, explaining how the money is spent. Lauraliisa motioned for the budget to be approved, and the Booster seconded. Budget approved unanimously. Annual dues and uniform costs need to be paid ASAP. This year's uniform costs have already come out of the budget and that will be replenished once all dues are paid.

SECRETARY REPORT

Amy explained the importance of an updated roster and asked all parents to fill in the google form that was emailed. Volunteering for the various committees was also encouraged.

VP FUNDRAISING REPORT

Jon was unable to attend the booster meeting so Lauraliisa reviewed all the fundraising campaigns that will take place this year. Team and individual goals were explained for each fundraiser. Campaigns include: Squad Funds – online giving; Poinsettia sales – sell plants or choose buy-out option; Golf Classic Tournament – largest of the fundraisers, need co-sponsors, will be held at Castle Hills in the Spring.

VP TECHNOLOGY REPORT

Tiffany explained that all team info is on the website and it is updated regularly. Schedules, photos, meeting minutes, Board information, etc. is all available on the website.

VP SOCIAL MEDIA/PR REPORT

Jason explained that media day will be coming up soon and to be on the lookout for details. This will include team photos as well as individual photos that will be used on social media and they will also be available for purchase through KO Photography. If you attend any golf team related events during the school year, send photos to Jason and he will add them to social media sites.

COACH'S REPORT

Coach Fields explained the Core Values of the golf team: Passion, Commitment, Discipline, Effort, Toughness, Pride.

Team structure – Hebron is in the top 5 in the area for number of players on the team. This year there will be 5 boys teams and 3 girls teams. The teams will be decided on based on qualifying rounds and these teams are fluid based on how players qualify during each qualifying session.

Practices -1st period will practice at Indian Creek twice a week from 7:30am to 9am. Meet at Indian Creek and then a school bus will drive students back to Hebron after practice. All other days will be practice at the Indoor Facility at school.

4th period practice – Indian Creek, Castle Hills, Coyote Ridge during class period Mon – Thurs. Coach will update Sports You with schedule so everyone knows where they are expected to be each day. Fridays is MVF (motivational video Friday) in the Indoor Facility at school.

Policies – <u>Transportation to practices</u> – if you need to carpool, sign up and the Board will connect you with other carpoolers. <u>Communication</u> – check Sports You, social media, and website. <u>Practices</u> – these are mandatory. Let Coach know if you cannot attend due to illness, appointments, etc. <u>Outside Events</u> – playing in Junior tournaments is encouraged. Do not have them overlap with school tournaments. The exception to this is if you have earned enough points to qualify for a top tournament. <u>Instruction</u> – outside instruction is encouraged, but it cannot happen during school instruction time per UIL rules. Outside instruction lessons must not start until after school release at 3:35pm. <u>Fittings</u>- get the right equipment. The correct clubs matter. Indoor <u>Facility/Trackman</u> – Just got second simulator. Coach arrives at 6:45am and golfers can go in and practice on simulators before class if needed. <u>Fundraising Participation</u> – We all have to do this together. All money raised goes directly to the team.

Things parents should know: 1.) Your golfers "why" 2.) What their plan is 3.) Support, support, support! Never let them see the back of your head 4.) Teach golf responsibility – let them take care of scoring, push cart, club cleaning, etc 5.) Don't compare them to other golfers and let them know you love to watch them 6.) 24 hour rule – Choose words wisely and don't make them talk about round immediately

if they don't want to. **7.)** Stop playing again perfect – it does not exist in golf **8.)** Preach integrity – reputation is everything in golf **9.)** Embrace adversity – they will learn through their struggles.
